

Captain Brian Hager Chief's Award August 2009

Captain Brian Hager was the recipient of the Chief's Award from Chief Larry L. Massey, Jr. in August 2009 for the work he did recently on a missing person's case that was reported 12 years ago. Conducting a follow-up investigation, Captain Hager was successful in locating the missing person's remains. Chief Massey citing Captain Hager's "... willingness to take on a heavier workload, along with your extensive experience as a seasoned criminal investigator..." as factors that led to the discovery of the missing person's remains. Chief Massey also stated "Your dedication has brought a measure of closure to the family of a missing person who anguished for so long. You have also brought the comfort of allowing for a proper funeral and resting place."

The Chief's Award is issued to members of the department, at the sole discretion of the Chief of Police, in special recognition of exceptional contributions to the goals of the department. Chief Massey stated "In this particular case, it's for sending a clear message to the community that we have great people working here who never give up."
