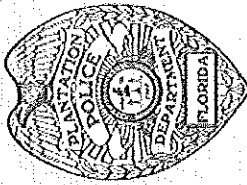

Justify Reasons

On July 6, 2010, Officer Miller along with Officer Walcott, Officer N. Diaz and Officer Walters responded to a medical call at 7061 NW 6<sup>th</sup> Court, regarding a female not breathing and blue to the face.

Officer Miller quickly responded to the scene and began administering life saving breaths to the female after a quick assessment and determined she was not breathing.

The additional officers arrived on scene and were able to help Officer Miller with aid to the female and scene management. Officer Miller's efforts allowed the female to gain responsiveness for Plantation Fire Rescue's arrival who continued care for the patient allowing for transport to Westside Regional Hospital. .

For his fast response and life saving efforts, I proudly nominate Officer Joseph Miller for the Plantation Police Department's Life Saving Award.

# Incident/Investigation Report

## Notes/Narrative

I was dispatched to 7501 NW 6th Ct in reference to a 23 year old female not breathing. Upon my arrival, I met with reporter Pozzi, who stated that his girlfriend Andujar was inside the house unconscious and blue in the face.

I observed a white female in the living room on the couch lying on her back. The female was still warm to the touch but completely unresponsive.

I immediately place her on a flat surface and began CPR until Plantation Rescue arrived. Shortly after rescue arrived Andujar regained consciousness and began breathing on her own. Andjar was transported to Westside Regional where she will be treated.

Investigation determined that Andujar is prescribed Oxycodone, Soma, Xanax and Seraquil. All prescriptions are from her primary Doctor Mr. Hylton for depression and a prior car accident. Adujar advised that she had no intentions on hurting her self she just had a bad reaction to the medicine
