Traffic Crash

On October 4, 2011 Plantation Police K-9 Officer Curtis Hampton and his K-9 partner Rudi were traveling eastbound on West Broward Blvd in the 6900 block when for reasons that are unknown a gold SUV, driven by Anne Jean-Louis Georges, crossed over the median and into the path of Officer Hampton's patrol car causing the vehicles to collide nearly head on. A black vehicle, driven by Ma Dre Fitzgerald Brown, was also traveling west on Broward Blvd behind Officer Hampton's patrol car when it struck the rear of the patrol car. Officer Hampton was airlifted to Broward General with serious injuries. Ms. Georges was transported to Broward General with non life threatening injuries, and Mr. Brown was treated and released at Westside Regional Medical Center. K-9 Rudi was transported to Hollywood Animal Hospital for treatment.

Officer Hampton is in stable condition; however, he has multiple fractures to both arms and both legs. He is recovering at Broward General.

K-9 Rudi is still recovering from injuries at the Hollywood Animal Hospital. He is expected to recover.
