MISSING PERSON

On March 20, 2010 at 7:50 PM Plantation Police responded to 1440 SW 82 Terrace in reference to a suspicious incident of a black male walking in the Plantation Colony development who appeared to be bleeding from the midsection of his body. The investigation revealed that, for reasons unknown, Paul Rowe left his residence by breaking through a closed glass bedroom window which appeared to have caused his injury. He then began to wander through the Plantation Colony development. A search for Paul Rowe by Plantation Police K-9 and the assistance of the BSO helicopter were met with negative results.

On March 25, 2010 the deceased remains of a male body was observed by Cornerstone management (1280 South Pine Island Road) floating in the lake. Plantation Fire Department responded to the scene at which time the body was recovered from the lake. It was determined that the deceased was that of missing adult Paul Rowe. There does not appear to be any signs of foul play.
